  - 2. <u>CCISD Professional Development and PLX</u>—The PLX/Professional Development survey centered on CCISD's professional learning program and the survey closed last week. Thank you to the 660 teachers who participated. There were also nearly 300 individual comments well worth reading. This is valuable information reflecting how the employees feel about

losing two contract days to attend mandated training that is inefficient and less than meaningful. Complete results with comments can be viewed/printed on our website atwww.ccaft.org. In short, 75% of those surveyed either "agree" or "strongly agree" that the two (PLX) contract days be returned to employees, and professional development be delivered during the workday.
