CCAFT members are being asked to provide more detailed lesson plans this year. Here is a brief response from the union with more information to follow.

Teachers are being asked to do excessive paper work around lesson plans constituting "busy work" for educators. Here is the law.

KNOW YOUR RIGHTS

Teachers are being burdened by needless paperwork around lesson plans. Here is the law-- Texas Education Code- Section 11.164. Restricting Written Information

11.164. (6) A unit or weekly lesson plan that **outlines**, in a **brief and general** manner, the **information to be presented** during each period at the secondary level or in each subject or topic at the elementary level.

**If your principal or district is asking for more than what is expressed in state law, please let us know.
